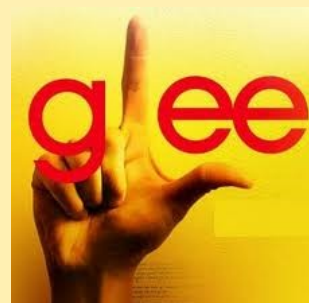
FEES

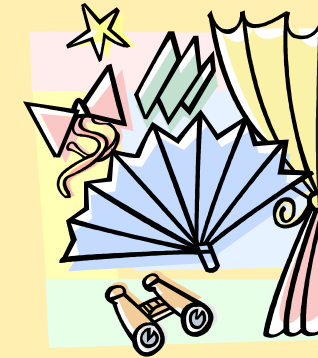
